From the Land Theme

Fiber arts practice is often rooted in place. From the fiber used to the inspiration given, the land around us produces both material and artistic vision. Land-based practices, livestock and plants, and the human hand come together to create textiles ranging from knitted garments to artistic tapestries.

For the 2021 Flag Wool & Fiber Festival Fiber Arts Competition, *From the Land*, we ask you to examine how the land around you influences your fiber arts practice. Whether you are influenced by local fiber or draw artistic vision from your environment, we want to see how the influence of land informs your work.

From the Land Exhibit and Award Details

The Fiber Arts Competition exhibition will open to the public on Saturday, June 5, 2021 at 9 a.m. Exhibit location on the festival grounds to be determined.

Ribbons and cash awards for all categories, including Best in Show, will be awarded on Saturday, June 5, 2021 at 9:30 a.m.

The People's Choice Award will be announced on Sunday, June 6, 2021 at 2 p.m.

Fiber Arts Competition Information, Rules, and Regulations

Fiber Arts Competition categories include basketry, crochet, felting, handspinning, knitting, macrame, needlework, weaving, sewing/quilting, surface design/dyeing, and collaborative guild/group project.

All items must have been made no earlier than May 30, 2019.

Each item must be entirely made by the entrant or collaborative guild/group named on the entry form.

An entry may be marked for sale if desired. Flag Wool and Fiber will handle the transaction and collect a 10% sales commission. The artist will be paid directly at the festival close on Sunday, June 6, 2021 at 4 p.m. To list an entry for sale, indicate the sale price on the entry form and include a business card with contact info/sale price along with the entry form. The business card will be attached to the entry after judging.

Entries are judged according to construction, suitability of material used, effective use for function, finishing, and adherence to the theme *From the Land*. Judging is done anonymously.

Retrieval of Fiber Arts Competition Entries

No entries are to be removed from the display area prior to festival close on Sunday, June 6, 2021 at 4 p.m. Entries can be collected at festival close or prior arrangements can be made to have your entry shipped back to you.
