All applicants will be notified of Flag Wool and Fiber's decision by January 16, 2020.

Please include *all* of the following information.

Class Information:

1. Class title.
2. Length of class: classes can be 2 hours, half-day (3 hours), full day (6 hours plus lunch break), or 2 or 3 days long.
3. Class description: This is for use on the Flag Wool website, and in other promotional materials. Please include what skills students will learn, and what projects they will complete in class or take home to finish. The class should sound interesting and fun.
4. Materials: Will there be a materials fee? If so how much, and what will it cover? What supplies and tools do students need to bring, if any? What will be provided?
5. Space and equipment required: Tables, chairs, water, electricity, etc. Please be specific about what you will need.
6. History of workshop (for FWF use only, will not be published): where and when have you taught this workshop in the past two years, and where else will you be teaching it in 2020?
7. Images: Please include at least 5 images that illustrate your proposed class. Images must be at least 1000pixels wide and 150dpi. One or two photos will be used in the workshop listing and the rest for advertising. Your images will help sell your workshop, please send us great pictures of your work!
6. History of workshop (for FWF use only, will not be published): where and when have you taught this workshop in the past two years, and where else will you be teaching it in 2020?
