

Instructors are invited to submit proposals for workshops to be held at the Flag Wool Festival, June 1-2, 2019. Three day classes are permitted to begin Friday May 31st.

Please submit your proposal via email to: [flagwool@yahoo.com](mailto:flagwool@yahoo.com) **no later than February 15, 2019**. Please attach proposals as a PDF or Word document, and submit a separate document for each class if you propose more than one.

All applicants will be notified of Flag Wool and Fiber's decision by February 16, 2019.

**Please include *all* of the following information.**

Class Information:

1. Class title.
2. Length of class: classes can be a half-day (3 hours), full day (6 hours plus lunch break), or 2 or 3 days long.
3. Class description: This is for use on the Flag Wool website, and in other promotional materials. Please include what skills students will learn, and what projects they will complete in class or take home to finish. The class should sound interesting and fun.
4. Materials: Will there be a materials fee? If so how much, and what will it cover? What supplies and tools do students need to bring, if any? What will be provided?
5. Space and equipment required: Tables, chairs, water, electricity, etc. Please be specific about what you will need.
6. Images: Please include one or two images that illustrate your proposed class. These can be snapshots, but please note that if the class is accepted we will need high quality images for promotion.

Instructor Information:

1. Name and contact information: Your email, mailing address, phone number, and website/blog etc.
2. Biography: Please include a paragraph describing your teaching experience/experience in this topic/why students would want to take a class from you, which will appear on the Flag Wool website if your class is accepted.
